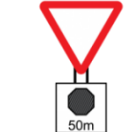

ADDITIONAL SIGNS



Compulsory pass from the left side. (passageway sign)



Compulsory pass from the right side. (passageway sign)



Compulsory pass from either side. (passageway sign)



Countdown markers may be provided when approaching a dangerous crossing. These divide the distance between the advance warning sign and the crossing into three equal parts



Sharp deviation of the route to the left at road works or other temporary obstruction.



Change direction towards right.



Change direction towards left or right.

TRAFFIC LIGHTS



Compulsory Halt-wait behind the queue

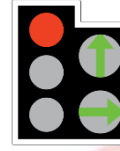
Yellow means stop. You may go if the yellow light appears after you have crossed the stop line or you're so close to it that stopping might cause an accident



When the yellow light is blinking this means drive slowly, because the road junction is not controlled by traffic light. In this case, the vehicle approaching from the right has priority unless a policeman in uniform is controlling traffic.



You may proceed if the road is free.



If a green arrow is shown with a red signal and the way is clear, you may go, but only in the direction shown by the arrow

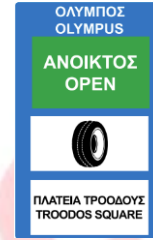

ROAD MARKINGS



Parallel continuous and broken lines. A single continuous white line along a broken white line means that overtaking is allowed only for the traffic that is on the side of the interrupted line.



Lane dividers overtaking is allowed with caution



Double white lines, no overtaking



Single white line, no overtaking



Yellow side line. No stopping



Double yellow. No stopping or parking



Broken side line. Indicates other entrances or exits on the left side of the road



White side line. Marks the limit of the road surface for use



Zig Zag lines
no stopping, no parking, no overtaking

SIGNS SHOWING EXIT DIRECTIONS AT A ROUNDABOUT (USE PROPER LANE)
